
## VOICE RECOGNITION GUIDE

QUICK TIPS
UCONNECT 4C/4C NAV
WITH 8.4-INCH DISPLAY





Start using Uconnect Voice Recognition with these helpful quick tips. This guide provides the key Voice Commands and tips you need to know to control your Uconnect 4C/4C NAV system.



### GET STARTED

For device pairing instructions and compatibility, visit **UconnectPhone.com** 

Insider tips on how to maximize your driving experience with voice recognition:

- Reduce background noise. Wind noise and passenger conversations are examples of noise that may impact recognition.
- Speak clearly, at a normal pace and volume, while facing straight ahead.
- Each time you give a Voice Command, you must first push either the VR or Phone button, wait until after the beep, then say your Voice Command.
- You can interrupt the help message or system prompts by pushing the VR or Phone button and saying a Voice Command from the current category.

To control your Uconnect system with your voice, all you need are the buttons on your steering wheel.



## GET STARTED



Push to initiate, answer, or end a phone call, and send or receive a text.

- 2. Uconnect Voice Recognition Button ( ).
  - a) Short Press: **Push and release** the VR button to begin Radio, Climate, Navigation (if equipped), Phone and Media functions. After you hear the single beep, say a command.
  - b) Long Press: **Push and hold, then release** the VR button for Siri functions. After you hear the familiar Siri "double beep," say a command.
  - c) Push and hold, then release the VR button for Siri or Google Voice functions.
- 3. Phone hang up button .

## BASIC VOICE

COMMANDS

The basic Voice Commands below can be given at any point while using your Uconnect system.

Push the VR button ( $\frac{\sqrt{6}}{\sqrt{8}}$ ). After the beep, say:

**Cancel** to stop a current voice session **Help** to hear a list of suggested Voice Commands Repeat to listen to the system prompts again

#### WARNING!

Always drive safely and obey applicable laws. Only use Voice Commands when it is safe to do so. Your attention should be focused on safely operating the vehicle. Failure to do so may result in a collision causing serious injury or death.



Notice the visual cues that inform you of your voice recognition system's status. Cues appear on the touchscreen above the main menu bar.

You can also use **Natural Language spoken phrases** (US English and 4C NAV only) for a few important features like calling a contact, tuning to radio, playing media, navigating to a POI, etc. Examples are provided on pages related to those topics.



RADIO

Use your voice to quickly get to the AM, FM or SiriusXM Satellite Radio station you would like to hear. You can also use Natural Language spoken phrases. (Subscription or included SiriusXM Satellite Radio trial required.)

Push the VR button ( $\frac{\sqrt{6}}{\sqrt{8}}$ ). After the beep, say...

Tune to Ninety-Five-Point-Five FM Tune to Satellite Channel Hits 1

Examples for Natural Language Command Phrases

I want to listen to One-Oh-One-Point-Nine FM.

I want you to change the FM station to Ninety-Five-Point-Five FM.





#### TIP

When you push the VR button ( ), the system will present a list of commands called teleprompter, say one of those commands. At any time, if you are not sure of what to say or want to learn a Voice Command, push the VR button and say "Help."



### **MEDIA**

Uconnect offers connections via USB, Bluetooth and auxiliary ports (if equipped). Voice operation is only available for connected USB and iPod devices. (Remote CD player is optional and is not available on all vehicles.)

Push the VR button . After the beep, say one of the following commands and follow the prompts to switch your media source or choose an artist/album/song/genre.

**Change Source to** Bluetooth

Change Source to iPod

**Change Source to USB** 

Play artist Beethoven; Play album Greatest Hits;

Play song Moonlight Sonata; Play genre Classical

Examples for Natural Language Command Phrases

I feel like listening to music by Beethoven.

I want you to play the song Moonlight Sonata.

#### TIP

Press the **Browse** button on the touchscreen to see all of the music on your iPod or USB device. Your Voice Command must match **exactly** how the artist, album, song and genre information is displayed.



### PHONE

Making and answering hands-free phone calls is easy with Uconnect. When the Phonebook button is illuminated on your touchscreen, your system is ready to make a phone call. You may have to wait for a few more moments to issue a Voice Command for hands-free calling.

#### U.S. and Canadian residents:

Push the Phone button . After the beep, say one of the following commands...

Call John Smith
Dial 123-456-7890 and follow the system prompts
Redial (call previous outgoing phone number)
Call back (call previous incoming phone number)

Examples for Natural Language Command Phrases I want to talk to John Smith.
I would like to dial 123-456-7890.



#### TIP

When providing a Voice Command, push the Phone button ( and say "Call" then pronounce the name exactly as it appears in your phonebook. When a contact has multiple phone numbers, you can say "Call John Smith <work, home, cell, etc.>."



### SIRI EYES FREE (If Equipped)

Available on iPhone 4S and later, Siri lets you use your voice to send messages, schedule meetings, place phone calls, and more. Siri is full engagement because it understands what you say, knows what you mean, and can even talk back. The system has been designed to help keep you focused by talking to Siri as if it were a person, which is just another way Siri helps you get things done, keeping your eyes on the road and hands on the steering wheel.

To begin, ensure Siri is enabled on your iPhone.

- 1. Pair your Siri-enabled device to your Uconnect System.
- Push and hold, then release the Uconnect Voice Recognition (VR) button (VR) on the steering wheel until you hear the familiar Siri "double beep."



### VOICE TEXT REPLY

Uconnect will announce **incoming** text messages. Push the Phone button and say "**Listen**." (Must have compatible mobile phone paired to Uconnect system.)

- 1. Once an incoming text message is read to you, push the Phone button and after the beep, say "Reply."
- Listen to the Uconnect prompts. After the beep, repeat one of the pre-defined messages and follow the system prompts.



- 1. Select "Settings."
- 2. Select "Bluetooth."
- 3. Select the (i) for the paired vehicle.
- 4. Turn on "Show Notifications."



## VOICE TEXT REPLY

#### PRE-DEFINED VOICE TEXT REPLY RESPONSES

Yes. Stuck in traffic. See you later.

No. Start without me. I'll be late.

Okay. Where are you? I will be

Call me. Are you there yet?

minutes late.

I'll call you later. I need directions.

I'm on my way. I can't talk <number>

right now. minutes.

Thanks.

#### TIP

Your mobile phone must have full implementation of the Message Access Profile (MAP) to take advantage of this feature. For details about MAP, visit **UconnectPhone.com**. Apple iPhone iOS6 or later supports reading incoming text messages only.

### **CLIMATE**

Û

Too hot? Too cold? Adjust vehicle temperatures hands-free and keep everyone comfortable while you keep moving ahead.

Push the VR button 🖟. After the beep, say...

Set driver temperature to 70 degrees
Set passenger temperature to 70 degrees

Examples for Natural Language Command Phrases It is too hot inside.

I feel too cold.



## AVAILABLE SERVICES

#### TIP

Voice Commands for Climate may only be used to adjust the interior temperature of your vehicle. Voice Commands will not work to adjust the heated seats or steering wheel.\*

\*If equipped.



### NAVIGATION (if equipped)

The Uconnect navigation feature helps you save time and become more productive when the system shows you exactly how to get to where you want to go.

1. To enter a destination, push the VR button  $\left(\begin{smallmatrix}\omega\xi\\\nu\rho\end{smallmatrix}\right)$ . After the beep, say:

For the 4C NAV Unconnect System, say:

Find Address 800 Chrysler Drive, Auburn Hills, Michigan. Enter state

For Point of Interest (POI), say: Find Nearest McDonalds

2. Then follow the system prompts.

Examples for Natural Language Command Phrases

Can you locate nearest McDonalds?

Take me to nearby grocery store.

Where is the nearest Starbucks?



## AVAILABLE SERVICES

#### TIP

To start a "Point Of Interest" (POI) search, push the VR button (VR). After the beep, say **"Find Nearest** coffee shop."



### UCONNECT + SIRIUSXM GUARDIAN

#### WARNING!

## ACTIVATE SERVICES



To unlock the full potential of Uconnect in your vehicle, you first need to activate SiriusXM Guardian connected services.

1. **Push** the **ASSIST** button on your rearview mirror.

- 2. Press the "SiriusXM Guardian Care" button on the touchscreen.
- 3. A helpful SiriusXM Guardian Care Agent will register your vehicle and handle all of the details.

#### Signing up is easy!

Simply follow the steps above. Or, press the "Apps \(\overline{\overline{O}}\)" button on the touchscreen, then select the Activate Services app to "Register By Web" to complete the process using your device or computer.

## MOBILE APPS

You're only a few steps away from a connected car experience.





#### To use the Uconnect App:

Search for and download the **Uconnect** app from the store on your compatible iPhone or Android-powered device.

- Log in to the app using the email address and password you created when you activated the services.
- Press the "Remote" button on the bottom menu bar of the app to lock/unlock, remote start (if equipped), and activate your horn and lights remotely.
- Press the "Location" button on the bottom menu bar of the app to bring up a map to locate your vehicle or send a location to your vehicle's navigation system.
- Press the menu button (three horizontal lines) in the upper left corner of the app to access settings and support information.

## SIRIUSXM TRAVEL LINK

Need to find a gas station, view local movie listings, check a sports score or the 5-day weather forecast? SiriusXM Travel Link is a suite of services that brings a wealth of information right to your Uconnect 4C NAV system. (SiriusXM Travel Link is not available on Uconnect 4C.)

Push the VR button . After the beep, say one of the following commands:

Show fuel prices.

Show 5-day weather forecast.

Show extended weather.



#### TIP

Traffic alerts provide you with an alternate route to help you avoid construction or delays from reported traffic incidents. Use your touchscreen to accept or decline the recommended reroute.
